

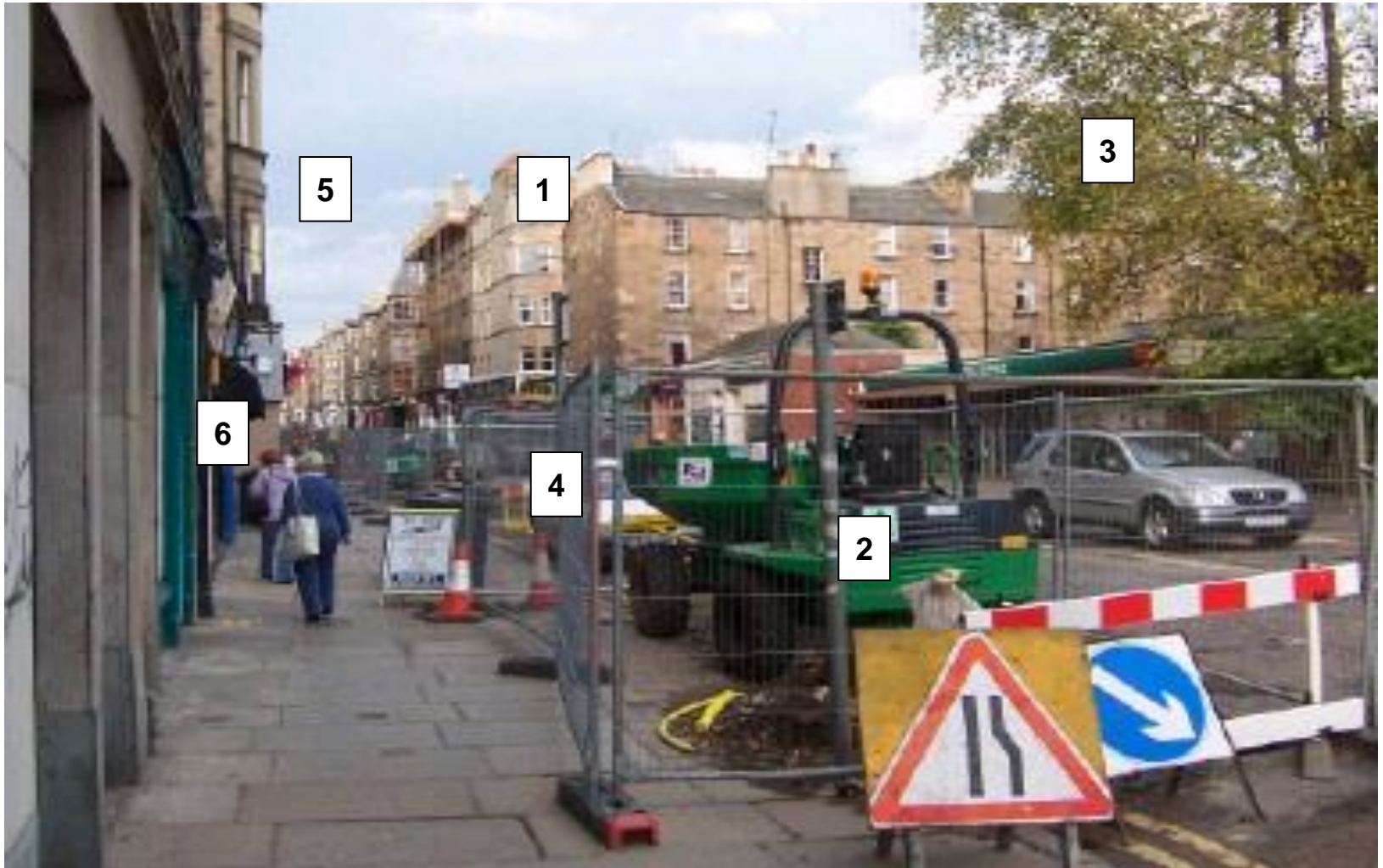

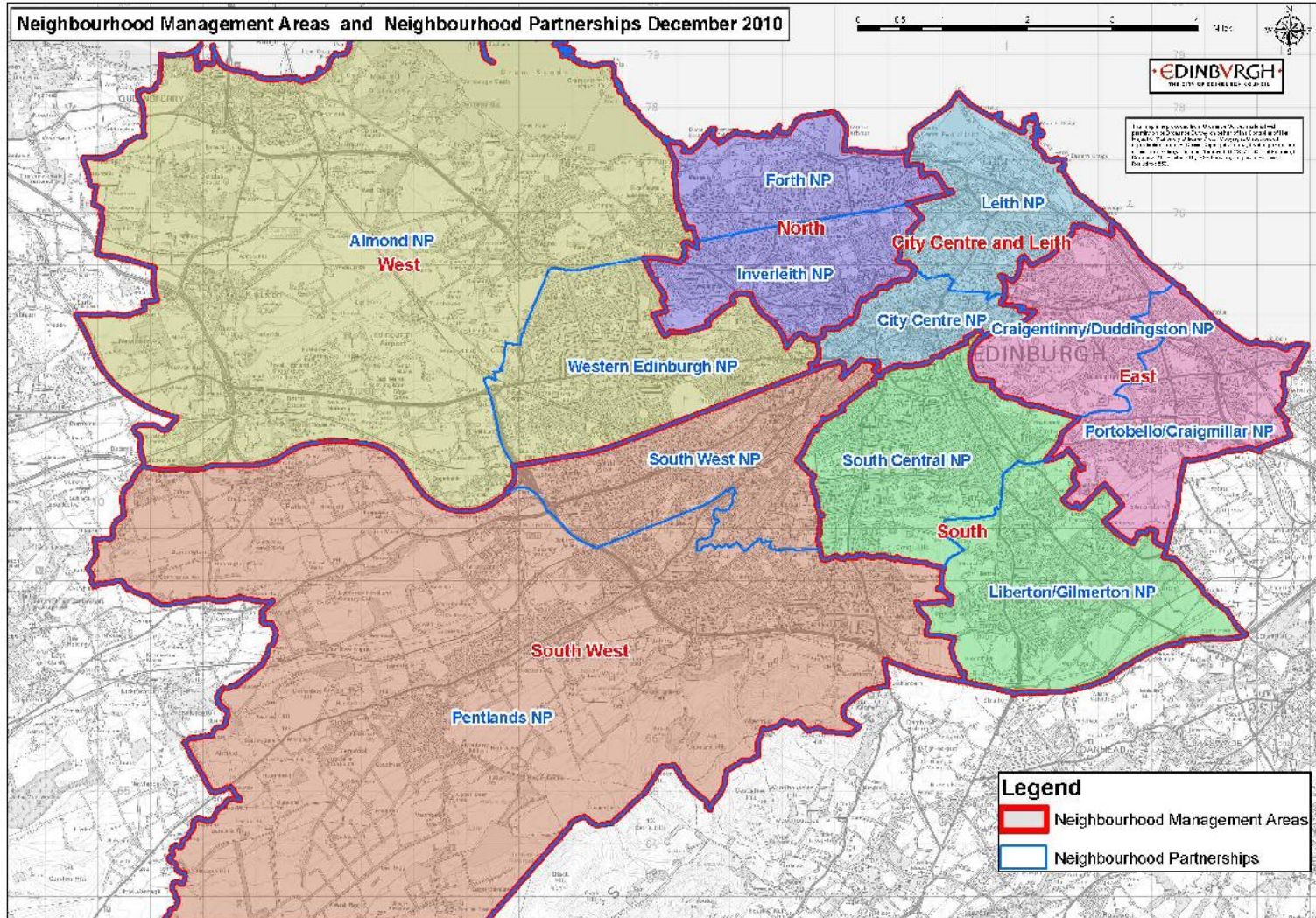

Street Cleaning

- 20 additional barrows each shift
 - 6 in Princes St Gardens
- 3 additional hired vehicles
- 5 additional night staff
- Large litter bins on street

- 10 additional Environmental Wardens
- Extended Patrolling – early and late
- Increased Community Safety patrols with Police – Operation Armour
