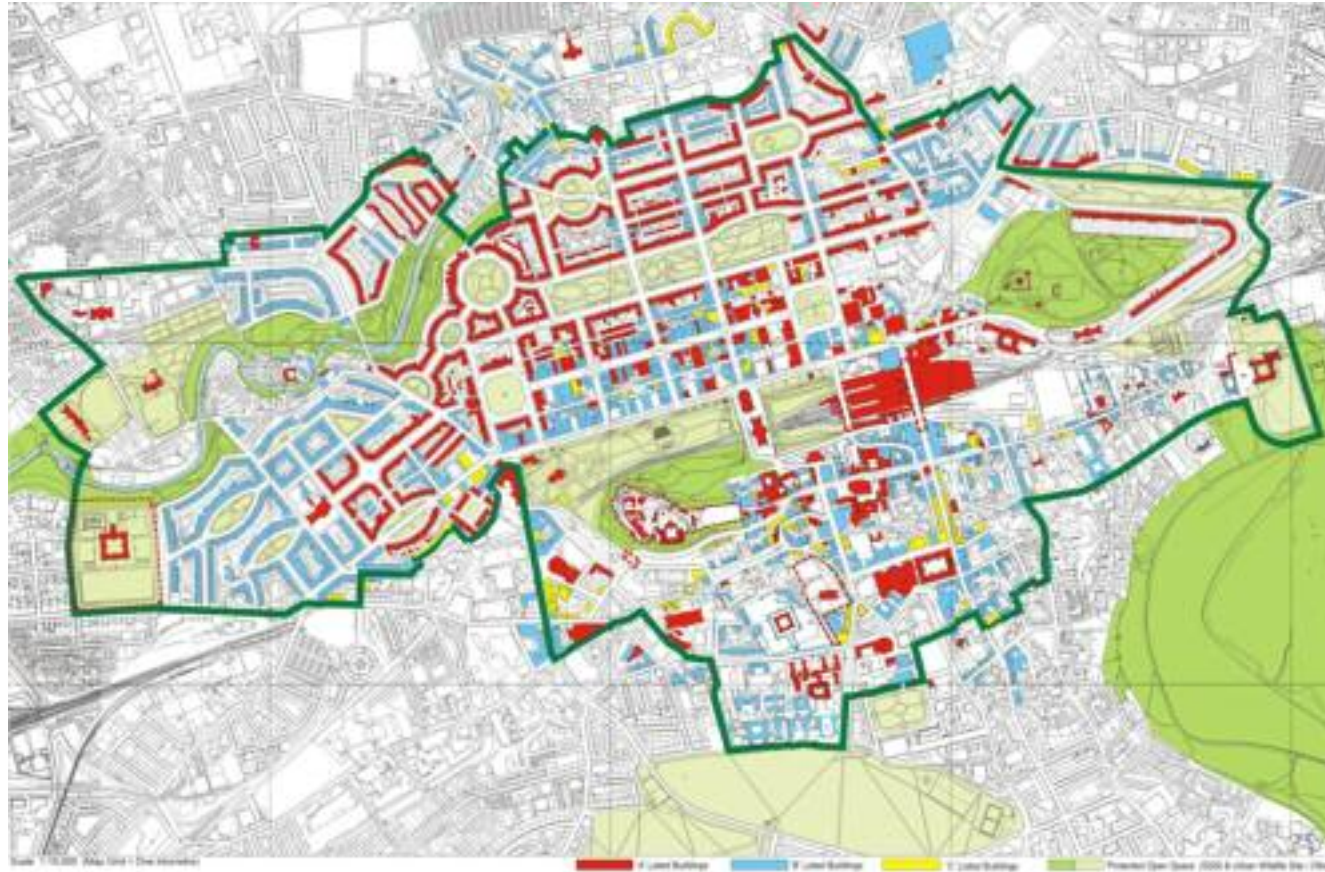

Edinburgh World Heritage Site: Listed Buildings



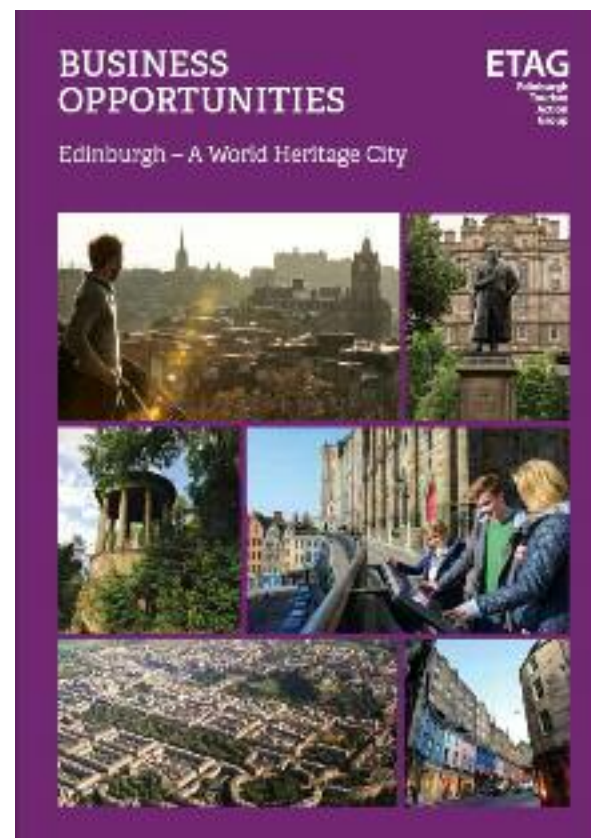

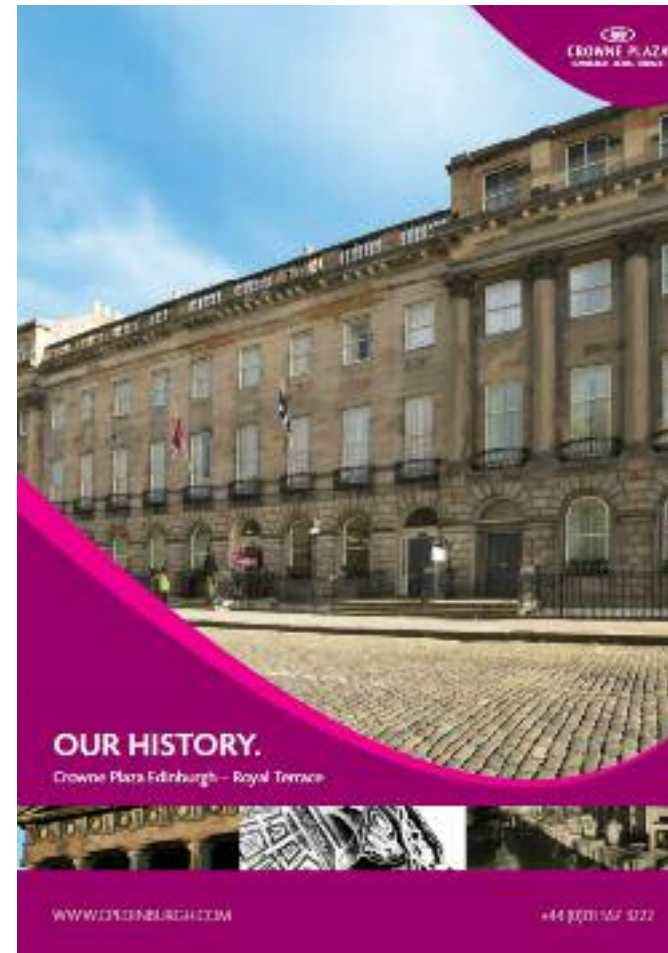
